

## **BIOGRAPHY**

I was born in 1961, and at that time, China was not strong in her economy, therefore, most people lived in poor conditions, so was I. My father died when I was 17 year old, and my mother took care of me alone. We had hard time when I was young. When I graduated in senior high school, it was the right time that the “Gang of Four” was knocked down and everything started to turn back to normal. Nursing School in Tianjin, which was abolished during the “Culture Revolution” was restored, therefore, I went to study Nursing there. My nursing career began in 1981 right after graduated in Nursing School, and I worked as an oncology nurse in Surgical Department of Tianjin Cancer Hospital which later became Tianjin Medical University Cancer Hospital till 2008. During 27 years, I studied oncology nursing in Royal Marsden Hospital for 8 months; went to Universities to study nursing all together 5 years; was pointed as a head nurse in charge of the Surgical Department of the hospital in 1987; and was selected as a board member of ISNCC in 2004. In Oct. 2008, I changed my job to work as an editor for the journal

“Clinical Oncology and Cancer Research” (COCR).

## **Current and Past Work with ISNCC**

In 2004, I was honored to be selected as a board member of ISNCC and since then I was actively involved in the activities related to ISNCC.

◇ I demonstrated in board member meetings and regional meetings that Chinese nurses have difficulties in participating ICCN as we can't afford the expenses for attending ICCN out of China without any financial support, therefore, ICCN could be held in China some day in the future, so that more Chinese oncology nurses would be able to participate; and that Chinese Association of the Nurses is a full member of ISNCC, which has over 80 thousand of Chinese oncology nurses, accounting for 10% of the members in ISNCC, therefore, we should play an important role in the activities of ISNCC. I also expressed that if there is a possibility for Chinese nurses to attend ICCN with a lowered registration fee.

◇ Helped with ISNCC (Former President, Margarete Fitch), the journal "Tianjin Nursing" created a column of ISNCC, which lasted for one year.

◇ Gave feedback to ISNCC regarding the changes in Constitution and Bylaw and raised some suggestions.

◇ Spread information related to ISNCC whenever give lectures national

wide.

◇ Published paper in nursing magazine to promote ISNCC to the nurses national wide.

◇ To act as a link person between our Association and ISNCC.
